


## INTRODUCTION

This State Lands Inventory Report presents a summary of the lands owned or managed by state agencies as of July 1, 1971. This second edition incorporates many changes and corrections to the first State Lands Inventory Report published in 1970.

The 1970 edition was the product of a reporting system which was developed to provide information on a county level relative to land uses on state owned or managed lands. This system was developed in accordance with Chapter 53, Laws of 1969. The 25 state agencies who own or manage state lands submitted their updates and corrections as of July 1, 1971. The State Lands Inventory Report for 1971 is a summary of the use, location and value of 3,642,370 acres and 12,680 miles of state owned or managed lands.

Forty-seven specific types of land uses are identified in this summary. They are based on land designations presently used in inventory records of state agencies, on terminology commonly used and understood by the general public, and on deliberations by a committee composed of representatives of nine state agencies, including those who collectively own or manage over 95% of all state lands.

Capital improvements on the lands are not included as part of this report. All lands are reported in terms of acres, miles, or number of sites. Facilities may be developed on them, but they are not identified in this reporting system.

It should be noted that this summary report relates to lands in terms of total acres or miles used, but not in terms of intensity of use.

The values of the state lands are based on the State Department of Highways acquisition records for 1967. A single estimated value was established for every use in each of the thirteen planning regions of the state. A cost appreciation factor has been included and the values reflect estimates for 1970.

This report was prepared by the Office of Program Planning and Fiscal Management. The cooperation of all boards, commissions, departments and other agencies of state government in preparing this state lands inventory is greatly appreciated.

## PRIMARY USE

## EXPLANATION OF "PRIMARY USE" TERMS

### Primary Use

Primary Use means the dominant use which normally occurs on a specified tract of land. Many other uses may also occur on the same tract of land.

1. Administrative Site (regional or district headquarters, office locations, etc. Note: Use only when site is separate from area recorded under one of the terms shown below.)
2. Agricultural
3. Aquatic (lakes, streams, swamps, etc., that cannot be measured in units or miles)
4. Beautification Area
5. Boating (marina, launch site, etc.)
6. Borrow Pit (contains gravel or similar material used as fill in building roads)
7. Camp (honor, youth, group, etc.)
8. Campus (community college, 4-year university, etc.)
9. Commercial
10. Commercial Forest (forest land which is producing or capable of producing industrial wood and not withdrawn from timber utilization)
11. Commercial Forest-Grazing (commercial forest land used for grazing)
12. Commercial Recreation (fishing, resorts, summer homes, golf courses; owned or leased by commercial groups and are recreation oriented)
13. Ferry Terminals
14. Fish Protective Facilities
15. Game Farm (where game birds are raised for release or restocking)
16. Game Range (open range land with brush managed primarily for wildlife open to hunting)
17. Game Range and Forest (partly open range and partly commercial forest land which is managed primarily for wildlife)
18. Game Range and Non-Commercial Forest (partly open range and partly marginal or non-commercial forest land which is managed primarily for wildlife)
19. Grazing
20. Hatchery

21. Historical (heritage, interpretive, etc.)
22. Hospital (treatment centers, state hospitals, etc.)
23. Industrial
24. Institution (correctional centers, reformatories, etc.)
25. Maintenance Site (shop areas, warehouses, etc. Note: Use only when site is separate. If part of administration site, record as administrative)
26. No Specified Use.
27. Non-Commercial Forest (unproductive forest land incapable of yielding crops of industrial wood because of adverse site conditions, and productive public forest land withdrawn from commercial timber use through statute or administrative regulation)
28. Non-Commercial Forest-Grazing (non-commercial forest land used for grazing)
29. Non-Renewable Resource (sand and gravel, silt, clay, earth, rock, basalt and volcanic rock, shale, granite, and mines)
30. Other
31. Oyster Lands
32. Recreation (recreation area, state parks, campground, etc.)
33. Research
34. Residential
35. Rest Stop (highway rest area, picnic site, visitor site, etc.)
36. Rights-of-Way (roads, power lines, etc.; includes lands acquired for these purposes but where construction is still pending)
37. School (educational institutions below college level - schools for handicapped, etc.)
38. 1st Class Tidelands
39. 2nd Class Tidelands
40. 1st Class Shorelands
41. 2nd Class Shorelands
42. Streambank Easements
43. Interstate Highway
