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Provide a detailed description of the proposed project:

The West Daybreak Restoration Project is located on the East Fork Lewis River, Clark County between river mile 9 and 10. The project site is west of the Daybreak Bridge, about 500 ft. downstream and continues approximately 4000 ft. downstream. This design for this project was funded in a previous RCO design grant, #08-1742. The project is located on a Tier 1 reach of the East Fork Lewis River, and benefits fall Chinook, chum, Coho, and winter and summer steelhead.

The project goal is to increase diversity and complexity in the river reach, as well as provide enhanced habitat for spawning, rearing, and migrant transient hotlind. The sponsor, Fish First, will enhance 1100' of side channel, install 5 large woody debris structures along 300' of the mainstem, and replant 1 acre of riparian buffer with native plants.

The project is located in Daybreak Park, managed by Clark County, and recreational uses include fishing and nature observation.

Property on the left bank of the project site is owned by Clark County and proposed for a regional park highlighting environmental stewardship, Right bank is primarily residential properties. Historically the left bank has been used for farming and pasture. There has been historical gravel mining along the river in the proximity of the site.
