Provide a detailed description of the proposed project:

Acquisition of all or part of two parcels on the left bank (4.3 acres) of the Twisp River, within Town of Twisp, mostly active floodplain and side channel. Properties include priority floodplain adjacent to Methow Salmon properties, which now encompass nearly 32 acres with ongoing restoration, environmental education activities, and a growing trail system. The parcels, though not currently for sale, are dividable, and development would result in further degradation of prime floodplain habitat. Securing these left bank parcels would allow removal of a protective levee that limits restoration potential in the sub-reach. Primary objective is to expand the restoration potential of these properties by purchasing and retiring adjacent development rights that limit riparian and floodplain restoration opportunities. ESA species affected are Upper Columbia steelhead, spring Chinook, and bull trout.

Describe existing project site conditions.

Larger parcel is a single family residence with appurtenant structures, of which only a portion will be acquired. Smaller parcel is mostly floodplain, which has been cut off from historic side channel meander through levee construction. This project area supports habitat needs for the ESA listed fish species: spawning, rearing and migration of Upper Columbia River (UCR) steelhead; migration, rearing, and limited spawning of UCR spring Chinook; and adult and sub-adult foraging, migrating and overwintering Columbia River bull trout.
