#### Provide a detailed description of the proposed project:

A stream crossing on Indian Creek (RM 0.2) in the Pend Oreille watershed (WRIA 62) blocks fish passage to approximately five miles of native salmonid habitat. The project is located on Indian Creek a Tributary to the Pend Oreille River. The project site is approxiamtely five miles north and west of Newport washington on the other side of the Pend Oreille River.

This project will develop project designs and specifications, construction cost estimate, and secure environmental permits (including wetland delineation and mitigation planning, if necessary) to be used for future implementation. When implemented, the project will:

1. Restore fish passage to approximately five miles of native salmonid habitat to Indian Creek, including three miles of currently designated (USFWS 2005) and five miles of proposed bull trout Critical Habitat (USFWS 2010);
  2. Restore natural stream processes, including large wood and sediment transport; and,
  3. Restore stream corridor passage for other aquatic organisms, such as amphibians.
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#### Describe existing project site conditions.
