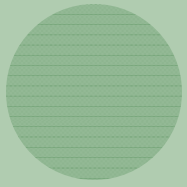


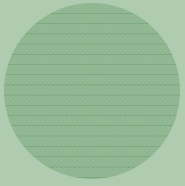

Washington Wildlife and Recreation Program
 - ◎ Grants that protect riparian habitat which includes, but is not limited to, shorelines and near-shore marine habitat, estuaries, lakes, wetlands, streams, and rivers.
 - ◎ Eligible Applicants: Cities, counties, towns, Federally recognized tribes, special purpose districts, some State agencies, lead entities, nonprofit nature conservancy organizations
 - ◎ Timeline:
 - ◎ Application Deadline: May 1, 2012
 - ◎ Funds Available: July 2013

 - ◎ Grant to implement conservation districts' long range and annual work plans that identify the highest priority natural resources issues in their area
 - ◎ Eligible Applicants: Conservation Districts
 - ◎ Timeline
 - Application Deadline: June 1, 2012
 - Funds Available: July 2012

CONSERVATION AND RESTORATION

- ⊙ Professional Engineering
 - ⊙ Grants to conservation district professional engineers to provide engineering services to landowners for implementation of best management practices, and to provide engineering oversight to conservation district technicians.
 - ⊙ Eligible Applicants: Conservation district "clusters," who coordinate on the hiring of a professional engineer and accomplish engineering work prioritized by each cluster

FARMLAND PRESERVATION

WATER, SEWER, AND TRANSPORTATION INFRASTRUCTURE

◎ Local Government Stormwater Grant Program

- ◎ The 2011 state Legislature provided a \$30,000,000 for stormwater construction or design/construction projects statewide that meet Municipal Stormwater NPDES permit requirements. Consideration will be given for communities least able to pay, or early adopters of new regulations and effective new technology.
- ◎ Eligible applicants are Phase I and Phase II Municipal NPDES Permit holders. Applicants must demonstrate readiness to proceed and provide a twenty-five percent cash match .

- ◎ Columbia River Program Grants
 - ◎ Grants to develop water supply for in-stream and out-of-stream uses
 - ◎ Eligible Applicants: Public and private entities in the Columbia River Basin with projects that will create water supply through modification of existing storage, new storage, conservation and/or acquisition
 - ◎ Timeline
 - Application period: Ongoing
 - Funds awarded as projects are selected

WATER, SEWER, AND TRANSPORTATION INFRASTRUCTURE

- ◎ Imminent Threat Grant
Community Development Block Grant
 - ◎ Grants to address unanticipated emergencies posing a serious and immediate threat to public health or safety facing rural communities.
 - ◎ Eligible Applicants: Cities and towns with less than 50,000 people and counties with less than 200,000 people if they do not participate in a Housing and Urban Development Urban County Consortium.
 - ◎ Timeline:
 - Application Deadline: Open all year
 - Funds Available: All year (on a funds available basis)

- ◎ Public Works Board Construction Loans

 - If the Legislature appropriates funding for the State Fiscal Year 2014 cycle, applications will be due May 10, 2012

Community Development Block Grant**
 - ◎ Grants for water, sewer infrastructure supporting state Housing Trust Fund financed affordable housing projects in rural communities.
 - ◎ Eligible Applicants: Cities and towns with less than 50,000 people and counties with less than 200,000 people, if they do not participate in a Housing and Urban Development Urban County Consortium.
 - ◎ Timeline:
 - Applications Deadline: Throughout the year
 - Funds Available: Follows Housing Trust Fund's Spring and Fall application cycles

WATER, SEWER, AND TRANSPORTATION INFRASTRUCTURE

- ◎ **General Purpose Grant
Community Development Block Grant**
 - ◎ Grants to fund public facility, economic development, and affordable housing projects to benefit lower income people and lower income rural communities
 - ◎ Eligible Applicants: Cities and towns with less than 50,000 people and counties with less than 200,000 people if they do not participate in a Housing and Urban Development Urban County Consortium.
 - ◎ Timeline:
 - Application Deadline: January (annually adjusted)
 - Funds Available: Early May (annually adjusted)

PLANNING

- ◎ Planning-Only Grant
Washington State Community Development Block Grant
 - ◎ Grants to fund priority planning activities to benefit lower income people and lower income rural communities.
 - ◎ Eligible Applicants: Cities and towns with less than 50,000 people and counties with less than 200,000 people if they do not participate in a Housing and Urban Development's Urban County Consortium
 - ◎ Timeline:
 - Application Deadline: Begin accepting applications in annually in March
 - Funds Available: May-December (ongoing, on fund available basis)

WASTE MANAGEMENT AND TOXICS CONTROL

- ◎ Local Source Control Program
 - ◎ Grants to local governments to help small businesses prevent polluted runoff to Puget Sound and the Spokane River Basin through good hazardous waste management and storm water control practices
 - ◎ Eligible Applicants: Local jurisdictions in the Puget Sound Basin and the Spokane River Watershed
 - ◎ Application Timeline and Grant Award Process:
 - ◎ Application period for this biennium is closed, it was open in June – 15 contracts have been awarded
 - ◎ With additional Puget Sound money from EPA, an additional RFP was issued, resulting in 15 new proposals that are now under review and awards will be made in September

WASTE MANAGEMENT AND TOXICS CONTROL

- ◎ Remedial Action Grant and Loan Program
 - ◎ Grants and loans to help pay the costs for investigation and cleanup of publicly-owned or abandoned contaminated sites.
 - ◎ Eligible Applicants: Local government
 - ◎ Application Deadline: There are different types of grants and loans available under this program. For the most part there is no set application period
 - Funds Available: July 1, 2011

WASTE MANAGEMENT AND TOXICS CONTROL

- ◎ Coordinated Prevention Grants
 - ◎ Grants to local governments for updating solid and hazardous waste management plans, implement projects in those plans, and support local enforcement of solid waste laws
 - ◎ Eligible Applicants: Counties, specified cities, local health jurisdictions
 - ◎ Timeline:
 - The primary application period ended August 30. However, there will likely be an offset cycle for the second year of the biennium. More information will be available in early 2012.

RECREATION

- ◎ Boating Infrastructure Grants
 - ◎ Grants to develop or renovate facilities for motorized boats larger than 26 feet in length

 - Funds Available: Spring 2013

RECREATION

- ◎ Water Access Category
Washington Wildlife and Recreation Program
 - ◎ Grants that provide physical access to shorelines for non-motorized water related recreation activities
 - ◎ Eligible Applicants: Cities, counties, towns, Federally recognized tribes, special purpose districts, ports, State agencies
 - ◎ Timeline:
 - Application Deadline: May 1, 2012
 - Funds Available: July 2013
 - ◎ Contact: Recreation and Conservation Office

RECREATION

- ◎ Clean Vessel Program Funds
 - ◎ The U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service provides Clean Vessel grant funding to states through the Sport Fish Restoration and Boating Trust Fund.
 - ◎ The Trust Fund comes from federal taxes on:
 - Sale of fishing equipment
 - Sale of motorboat fuels, and
 - Import duties

RECREATION

- ◎ Clean Vessel Program Availability
 - ◎ Grants are available for **construction and operation and maintenance** of
 - pump-outs,
 - floating restrooms,
 - dump stations
 - or other systems that will provide an environmentally sound method of disposal for recreational boating sewage.

RECREATION

- ◎ Clean Vessel Program Eligible Applicants Include:
 - ◎ Private and public marina and other boating facility operators. The facility must be open to the recreational boating public.
 - ◎ Both marine and in-land freshwater facilities are eligible
 - ◎ The applicant must fund 25% of the project from non-federal funds. Work is paid for up-front by the applicant and when complete and accepted by State Parks, is reimbursed at 75%.
 - ◎ Construction must be completed within two years of award.
 - ◎ Grants may include reimbursement of up to 75% of annual operating expenses including staff salary and benefits for 10 years or the usable life of the equipment which ever is longer.

RECREATION

- ③ Clean Vessel Program Timeline
 - ③ Applicants may apply at any time during the year. Approved projects will be funded as long as funding is available.
 - ③ Occasionally, grants without a 25% match requirement may be made available. Prospective applicants will be notified of such funding opportunities by e-mail or other means. Opportunities for full funding are highly competitive and have tight deadlines for project completion.

RECREATION

- ◎ Clean Vessel Program Target Locations
 - ◎ Priority will be given to projects that support the Governor's Clean Water Initiative, Puget Sound Partnership Action Agenda, or the Hood Canal Coordinating Council Integrated Watershed Management Plan.
 - ◎ Desirable project locations may also be found in the Department of Ecology 2008 Washington State Water Quality Assessment in areas testing high for fecal coliform, and
 - ◎ As identified in the 2001 Washington State Boating Sewage Disposal Facilities report by BST Associates available through State Parks.

RECREATION

- ◎ Clean Vessel Program Reporting Requirements
 - ◎ After September 30th each year, State Parks sends all current grant recipients an Annual Gallonage Report request form and an Operation and Maintenance (O&M) reimbursement request form.
 - ◎ All grant recipients are required to return the Gallonage report letting State Parks know how much sewage was pumped during the previous federal fiscal year. This report is required before any annual O&M reimbursement request will be processed and is used to justify the next year's grant requests
 - ◎ The annual O&M reimbursement request form is submitted to State Parks with the Gallonage report and must include copies of invoices, and documentation of staff time that match the amount requested for reimbursement.
